



Training Example Logic Model

ABC Youth Project

Problem Statement: ABC Neighborhood in north Flint has a 10 percent increase in blighted homes from last year and a 5 percent increase in violent crimes. Additionally, in the past three years, 3 percent less youth are graduating from high school and fewer are choosing to attend post-secondary education.

Goal: Increase the number of youth graduating from high school and attending post-secondary education while reducing the number of blighted areas in ABC Neighborhood, and hence reducing crime.

Brief Program Description: ABC neighborhood association, in north Flint, using a fiscal sponsor, has written a grant proposal to RMF requesting funds to develop youth employment skills through mentoring and curriculum implementation while working to enhance blighted areas.
